

***Field Technician (summer)***

The South of the Divide Conservation Action Program Inc. (SODCAP) is looking for personable, organized and self-motivated individual(s) to be the summer technician(s). The ideal candidate will possess:

- Native plant identification skills
- Knowledge of the Saskatchewan Range and Riparian Health Protocol
- The ability to work as a team player while being able to work with very limited supervision, in all types of weather
- Knowledge of species at risk, range management, and agricultural activities that take place in the South of the Divide area (the Milk River Watershed)
- Strong organizational, critical thinking, and coordination skills
- Confidence to work in remote locations in southwestern Saskatchewan
- A valid drivers licence and vehicle in good operating condition. This position requires significant travel within southwestern Saskatchewan

This is a summer Field Technician position. Job duties may include:

- Habitat assessments for Greater Sage Grouse and Sprague's pipit (training will be provided)
- Mapping of leafy spurge and other invasive weeds
- Riparian health assessments
- Assisting with livestock producer-oriented workshops and events as needed
- Organizing and entering data

The contract will commence May 1, 2019 and conclude August 31, 2019. Payment will be based on experience. This position will require physical activity in all types of weather. It will also require a flexible work schedule.
